- Captions

- Colourful and eye catching
- Consistency and flow throughout the diary

Written Content:

- Contents page
- How you got your pet
- It's needs-food, shelter, care and attention
- Personality of pet
- Unusual/funny habits
- Regular routines
- Your feelings towards your pet
- Time spent with your pet
- Your pet's future after pet day
- Glossary
- Frequent entries – observation, changes in our pet's behaviour etc

Pictorial Content:

- Photos
- Pictures
- Sketches
- Info graphics
- Flow charts
- Graphs
- Samples e.g. grasses
- Cartoons
